The winning edge

College athletes have more job options open to them than their less sporty fellow students

EVER wonder what became of your favorite college athlete? If the professional sports world takes a pass on such talent, where do

they end up?

Bear in mind that these people are likely to be driven, team players.

If you guessed Wall Street or the entertainment industry, sure, a fair share enter these arenas.

But in the eat-or-be-eaten world of corporate America, employers such as the pharmaceutical and medical device fields are quickly recognizing the drive and fortitude of this population and hoping to attract more student sportspeople to their staff.

"I'm seeing corporations take a longer look at student athletes," says Chris Monasch, director of athletics for St. John's University.

"They are competitors by nature. Similar to the business world, their leadership skills and focus are measured every day by whether they win or can bounce back from a loss quickly."

Time-management is

another common trait which is displayed by top sports players, and this is also strongly valued by today's employers.

With numerous practices, travel and team meetings, athletes are logging in 30 to 40 hours a week for their sport, in addition to their studies.

"They have a strong work

every time over someone less sporty but of equal intellect.

"While there are exceptions to every rule, I believe there would be a higher level of maturity from such candidates," said Jon C. Garito, Ph.D., president of Ellman International, LLC, a leading medical device designer and manufacturer based in Ocean-side, New York.

"College athletes seem to have a great number of qualities which transfer easily to medical device sales specialist success."

In fact, the company already boasts three salespeople with

Personal online tutoring can help raise test scores

THE countdown to the big day is on. You're just months away from taking the exam that could tilt the scale in or out of your favor for being accepted to the college or graduate school of your dreams.

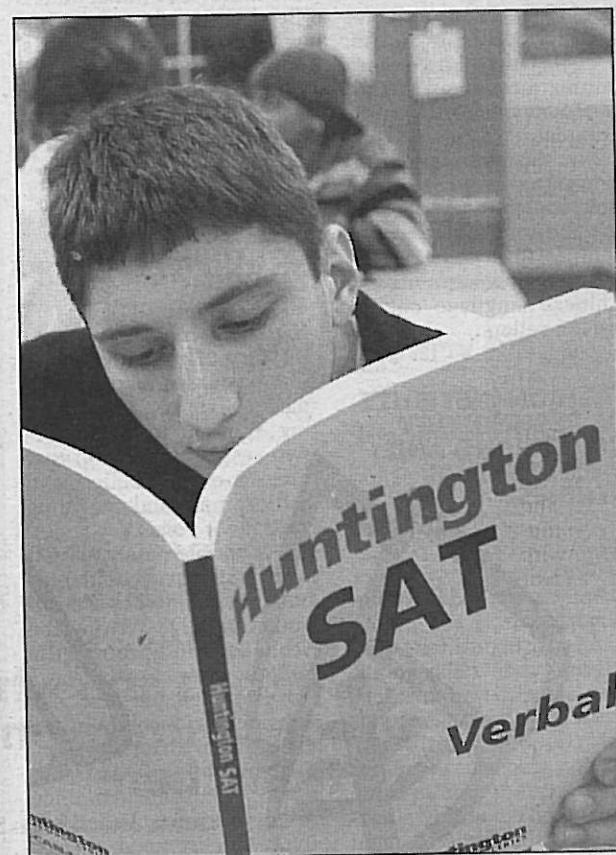
With little time in your busy day to tackle homework, reading assignments and term papers, how will you pencil in time for extra test-help sessions?

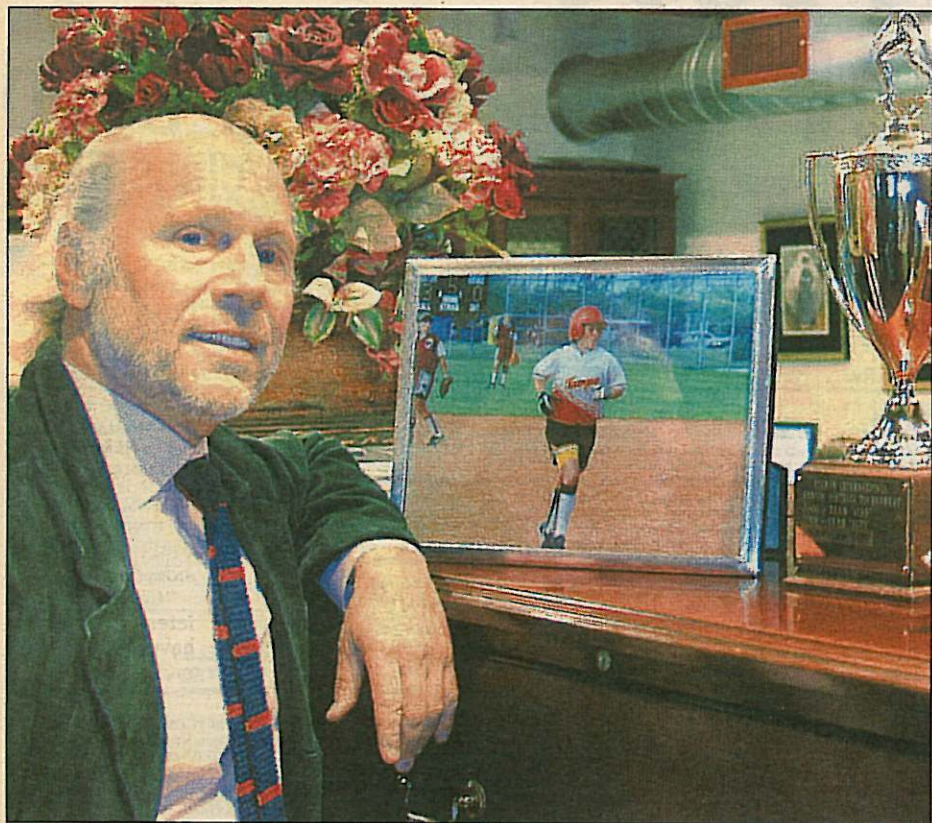

is used in both physical and electronic classrooms, the benefits include real time tutoring, virtual coaching, the flexibility and the convenience factors, as well as the privacy.

"You don't have to deal with other students' questions, whether they're faster or slower than you," added the executive.

Here's how it works.

Using voice-over Internet Protocol (IP) technology via a headset, a student connects online to a virtual classroom and whiteboard.

There to 'meet' and to communicate with the student is the personal tutor, who follows a syllabus, poses questions and marks up instructional slides.

So far, The Princeton Review employs a stable of 20 online tutors, but more are in training and on the way.

"We invite the cream of the crop of our in-person teaching staff to train to become live, online instructors," said Deutsch.

"Then, we further ask the best of that group to participate in live, online tutoring."

The fee for this premium learning service ranges and depends upon what type of test a student is studying for (GMAT, LSAT, GRE, SAT, ACT.)

For example, an 18-hour, online tutoring package for the SAT is priced at \$2,000.

For Ingrid Oelschlager, her first experience with the company's SAT package was a definite winner.

After receiving an introductory package in the mail, which includes practice and diagnostic tests, Ingrid was instructed by her online tutor (based in Oregon) to complete a four-hour practice test online.

"My online tutor was able to determine my strengths and weaknesses and what to concentrate on from there."

"In my case, my weakness was the verbal section," she explained.

Due to the lack of face-to-face contact coupled with background noise distractions by members of her household, Ingrid admits the experience was challenging at times.

However, she's pleased with the results of her training and wouldn't hesitate to sign up for more online tutoring in the future.

"I took another full length practice test and my verbal score alone went up by nearly 200 points," she said.

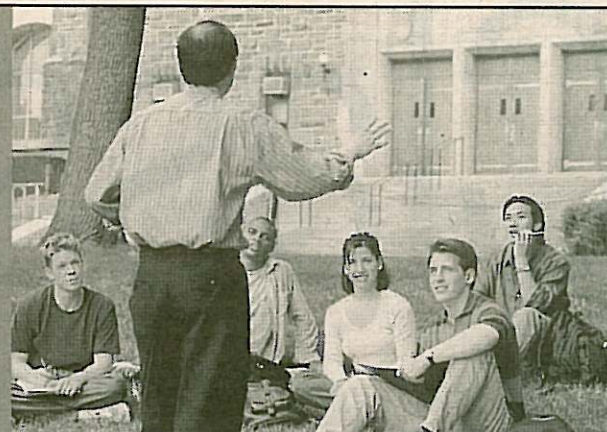

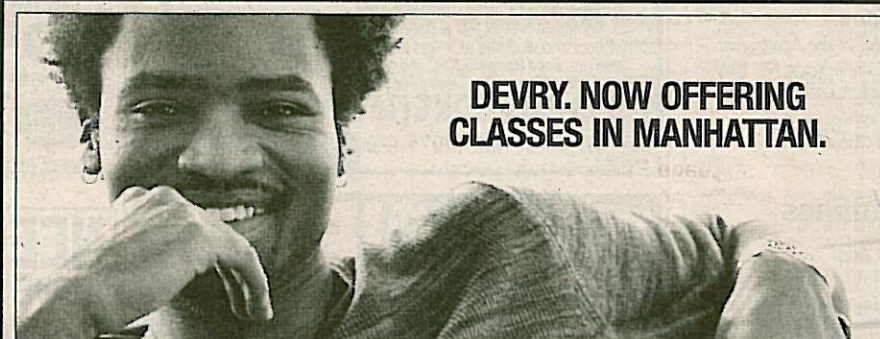
